

To Foreigners who have Changed Their Status of Residence or Period of Stay Since April 27th  
Explanation of the Special Cash Payment (100,000 yen per person)

Those who satisfy all of the following (1) through (3) are eligible to receive the Special Cash Payment (100,000 yen per person):

- (1) Had registered with the Basic Resident Registration System, but changed to a visa for a period shorter than three months (short-term stay) prior to April 27, 2020;
- (2) Was living in Japan on April 27, 2020; and
- (3) Registered with the Basic Resident Registration System after April 27, 2020 due to change of residential status or period of stay.

[Required documents]

- Application Form
- A document demonstrating that the eligible person had registered with the Basic Resident Registration System on a date before April 27, 2020 (required for each eligible member of the household)

Example: A copy of the residence card of that time  
Certificate of residence record deletion

- A document demonstrating that the eligible person was living in Japan on April 27, 2020 (required for each eligible member of the household)

Example: A copy of the passport  
The page that shows the eligible person's name and date of birth  
The page with a visa indicating that the eligible person was in Japan at that time
