



# Services for Children with Disabilities

## Protection Handbook (*Aigo-techo*)

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

This handbook is issued to persons with certain intellectual disabilities upon application. Presentation of the handbook is required when using various welfare services.

**Eligibility** Persons whose intellectual disabilities appear during the developmental period (generally up to age 18) and who require some form of assistance due to difficulties in daily life

## Physical Disability Certificate

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

This certificate is issued to persons with certain physical disabilities upon application. Presentation of the certificate is required when using various welfare services.

**Eligibility** Persons with impairments of the visual, hearing, equilibrium, voice, speech, or mastication functions; physical disabilities (including cerebral motor dysfunction); or dysfunction of the heart, kidneys, respiratory organs, bladder or rectum, small intestine, immune system, or liver

## Mental Disability Certificate

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

This certificate is issued to persons with certain mental disabilities upon application. Presentation of the certificate is required when using various welfare services.

**Eligibility** Persons with mental disorders who have long-term limitations in daily or social life due to their mental disabilities

## Welfare allowance for children with disabilities (income limit applies)

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

This allowance is provided to persons with severe disabilities who are cared for at home.

**Eligibility** Persons under 20 years of age who require constant care in daily life due to severe disabilities as defined by government ordinance

## Special Child Support Allowance (income limit applies)

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

This allowance is provided to those who are raising children under 20 years of age with physical or mental disabilities.

**Eligibility** Parents or guardians who care for children under 20 years of age with certain physical or mental disabilities (including intellectual disabilities)

## Medical subsidy for persons with disabilities (income limit applies)

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Health Insurance and Pension Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

A subsidy is offered to cover medical expenses of persons with certain disabilities. Eligible persons will be issued a Medical Care Certificate for Persons with Disabilities. Please present it together with your My Number health insurance card or equivalent at the reception desk of hospitals or clinics.

**Eligibility** Holders of a Physical Disability Certificate (Grade 1–3; Grade 1–4 for those with kidney dysfunction; Grade 1–6 for those with progressive muscular atrophy); holders of a Mental Disability Certificate (Grade 1–2); persons assessed as having an IQ of 50 or below; persons diagnosed with autism; and holders of a Specific Medical Expense Recipient Certificate (for designated intractable diseases) who meet certain requirements

## Aichi Prefecture allowance for persons with severe disabilities cared for at home (income limit applies)

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

Children with severe disabilities who are cared for at home are eligible to receive this allowance.

**Eligibility** Children with certain severe disabilities who are cared for at home

## Benefit for persons (children) with severe disabilities (income limit applies)

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

Children with severe disabilities who are cared for at home are eligible to receive this benefit.

**Eligibility** Children with certain severe disabilities who are cared for at home

## Mutual-aid program to support persons with mental or physical disabilities

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

This program is funded by premiums paid by parents of children with disabilities. When a parent dies or becomes severely physically disabled, a pension is provided to the child from the fund.

**Eligibility** Parents who support a child with disabilities that meet certain requirements and who are in good health without any special illness or disability (under 65 years of age as of April 1 of the year of enrollment)

## Subsidies for assistive devices (income limit applies for those aged 18 and over)

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

Persons with certain disabilities are eligible to receive a subsidy covering part of the cost of purchasing assistive devices when such purchases are deemed necessary.

**Eligibility** Holders of a Physical Disability Certificate and patients with intractable diseases or other conditions without such a certificate



## Subsidies for daily living aids (income limit applies for those aged 18 and over)

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

Daily living aids for children with severe disabilities are provided for eligible recipients.

**Eligibility** Children with certain disabilities



## Subsidy for purchase of hearing aids for children with mild to moderate hearing impairment

**Inquiries** Child Welfare Division, Child and Youth Affairs Bureau ☎052-972-3187

A subsidy is provided to cover part of the cost of purchasing hearing aids for children with mild to moderate hearing loss who are not eligible for a Physical Disability Certificate, in order to improve their hearing and promote language development.

**Eligibility** Those who meet all of the following requirements:

- Persons under 18 years of age who reside in Nagoya City (For those who reach the age of 18, the subsidy is provided until March 31 of the fiscal year in which they turn 18.)
- Persons with a hearing level of 30 dB or more in principle, whose impairment is not severe enough to qualify for a Physical Disability Certificate
- Persons who have been diagnosed by a physician as requiring the use of a hearing aid



## Reduction or exemption of water and sewerage charges

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

Water and sewerage charges are reduced or exempted for recipients of the Special Child Support Allowance and those receiving the Basic Disability Pension for disabilities that developed before the age of 20 (limited to heads of households).

**Eligibility** Recipients of the Special Child Support Allowance or the Basic Disability Pension for disabilities that developed before the age of 20 (limited to heads of households)



## Consultation support service

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

For children using disability day services and for users of disability welfare services, a support utilization plan is created and service use is monitored regularly.

**Eligibility** Children using disability day services and users of disability welfare services

**Fee** Free



## Child development support service

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

Children with disabilities receive guidance in basic daily activities and training to help them adapt to group environments.

**Eligibility** Preschool children with disabilities who are recognized as needing therapeutic or developmental support

**Fee** 10% of the total service cost (A monthly upper limit applies, depending on income.)

\*User fees are waived for children in the 0- to 5-year-old class.



## On-site support at nursery schools/daycare centers

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

Specialized support is provided to children with disabilities who are attending or planning to attend a nursery school/daycare center so that they can adapt more easily to group environments.

**Eligibility** Children with disabilities who are attending or expected to attend a nursery school/daycare center, and who are recognized as needing support

**Fee** 10% of the total service cost (A monthly upper limit applies, depending on income.)

\*User fees are waived for children in the 0- to 5-year-old class.



## Home-visit child development support service

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

This service is intended for children with disabilities who are recognized as having great difficulty going out. Supporters visit their homes to help them learn the basic activities of daily living, acquire knowledge and skills, and adapt to group environments.

**Eligibility** Children with disabilities who are recognized as having great difficulty going out and receive child development support or after-school day services due to a severe disability or a comparable condition—such as requiring daily medical care or being at high risk of infection because of a serious illness—are eligible.

**Fee** 10% of the total service cost (A monthly upper limit applies, depending on income.)

## After-school day service

**Inquiries** Ward Office: Welfare Division; Branch Office: Resident Welfare Division

Children with disabilities receive training and other activities to help improve their abilities after school hours or on school holidays.

**Eligibility** Children with disabilities who are enrolled in school (excluding kindergarten and university) and are recognized as needing support

**Fee** 10% of the total service cost (A monthly upper limit applies, depending on income.)

## Disability welfare services

**Inquiries** Welfare Division, Ward Office (for residents living in an area covered by a ward branch office: the Resident Welfare Division)

Children with disabilities receive welfare services such as home-help services and short stays.

**Eligibility** Children with disabilities who are recognized as needing support

**Fee** 10% of the total service cost (A monthly upper limit applies, depending on income.)

## Nagoya Dental Health Care Centers (Dental care for persons with disabilities)

**Inquiries** Medical Welfare Division, Health and Welfare Bureau ☎052-972-2574

Consultation and dental treatment are provided for children and adults with disabilities who have difficulty accessing dental care in their community. (\*Appointment required)

**Eligibility** Holders of a Physical Disability Certificate (Grade 1–3) or a Protection Handbook (*Aigo-techo*) (Grade 1–3)
