Emergency Evacuation

On Wednesday, June 22, around 11:00 a.m., an unexploded bomb (250 kg type) was discovered in Obata Minami 3-chome, Moriyama Ward.

From Sunday, July 30, 10:00 a.m., the Ground Self-Defense Force will remove the bomb.

Due to the risk of an explosion during removal, there will be an evacuation zone set as shown on the reverse side of the sheet. The zone will be completely sealed off for your safety. If you live within the evacuation zone, **you must evacuate** outside the area by 9:30 a.m. Also, note that you **will not** be able to enter the evacuation zone for **any reason** during the removal process.

The removal process may not be finished until the evening or later. Evacuation shelters will be available at the locations listed below. **However, you may stay anywhere as long as it is outside of the evacuation zone.**

Evacuation Shelters

- Naeshiro Elementary School (10-6, Naeshiro 2-chome, Moriyama Ward)
 - Naeshiro Community Center (19-12, Obata Minami 1-chome, Moriyama Ward)
 - Moriyama Higashi Junior High School (7-3, Obata 5-chome, Moriyama Ward)
- * All three locations will be available for shelter from 8:30 a.m. to until the bomb is removed.

[Attention]

- 1.) Make sure to turn off any fire sources, and lock your doors before evacuating.
- 2.) Do not drive to an evacuation shelter.
- 3.) If you must evacuate by car, leave with time to spare in case of traffic jams.
- 4.) As soon as the bomb removal is completed, we will announce the lifting of the evacuation order through wireless broadcast system, public announcement vehicles, and other methods. Information will also be provided on the City of Nagoya Official Website and via the Nagoya Oshiete Dial. Only available in Japanese.
- 5.) Air conditioners at evacuation shelters will not be turned on.
Bring your own food and drinks to the evacuation shelter.
- 6.) If there are elderly people living alone or people with disabilities living in the neighborhood, reach out to each other and work together to evacuate.

- 7.) The removal will be held even in bad weather. If it cannot be held due to disaster-level heavy rain or other reasons, Sunday, August 6 will be set as a backup date.

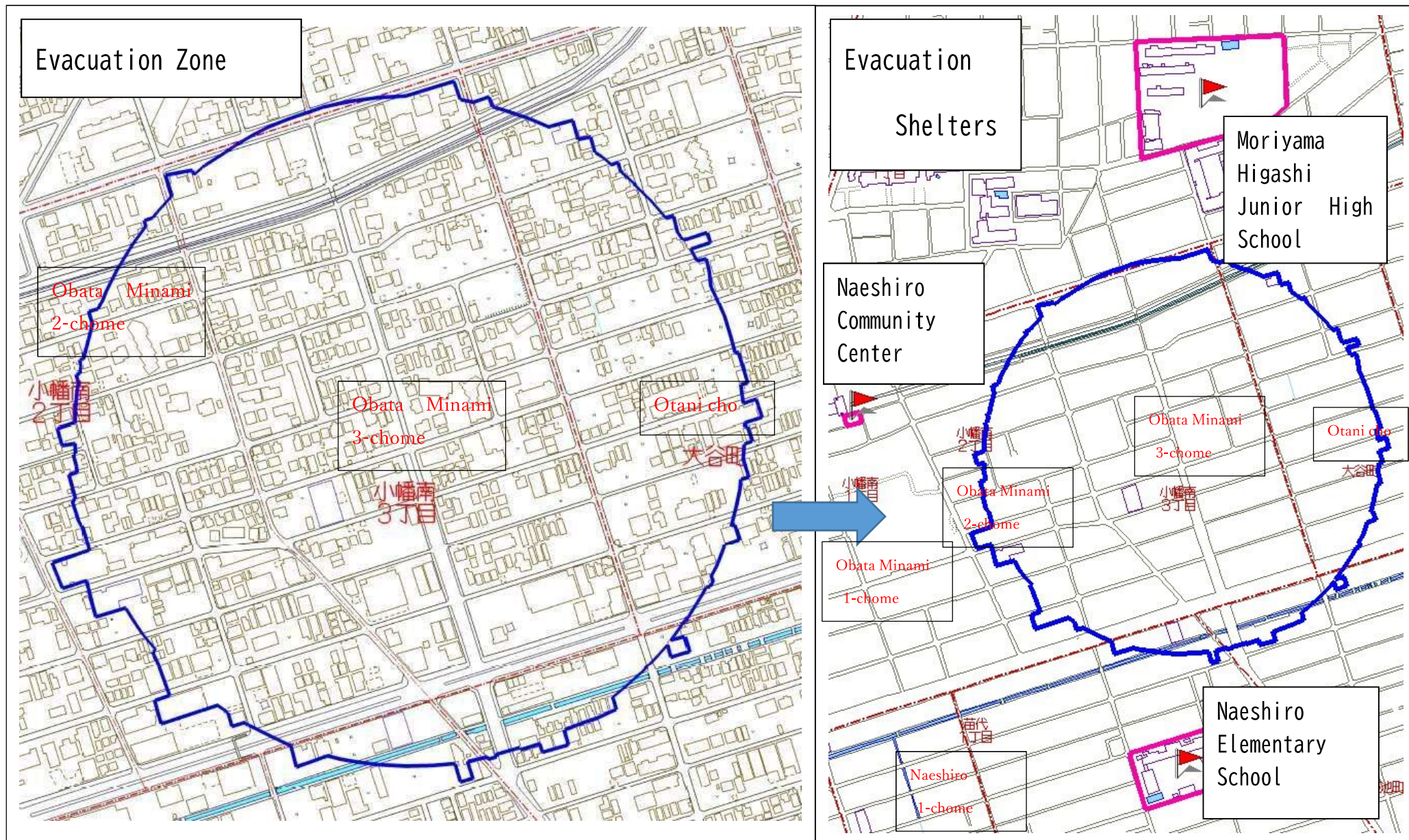
