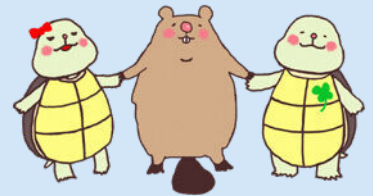




Nagoya City Work and Living Independence Support Center



Those who have various worries about their daily life, including work, family finances, and family members, should feel free to consult with us. (Those receiving public assistance called *Seikatsu Hogo* in Japan are ineligible for the service.)

Consultation and Support Program for Living Independence

**First, please consult with us.
We will work on a solution together.**

If you have any troubles or worries in your daily life, please first talk with the consulting service center in your vicinity. We will work with you to determine what kind of support you need, draw up a specific support plan, and provide support to help you become self-sufficient.

Housing Security Benefits

We will subsidize a portion of your rent and relocation expenses.

For those who are at risk of losing their home due to unemployment or other reasons, we will provide an amount equivalent to their rent for a certain period of time, on the condition that they actively look for work. In addition, for those who are at risk of losing their home due to a significant decrease in income, we will provide a portion of the relocation expenses, as long as we judge the assistance is needed as support for improving their household's financial situation. Various conditions such as level of income and savings must be satisfied to receive the benefits.

Support Program for Household Financial Improvement

We offer advice on how to restore your household's finances.

We will draw up a support plan tailored to your situation, such as "visualizing your household finances," so that you can manage your household finances in a well-planned manner. We provide debt counseling, referrals to loan companies if needed, and other services in a timely manner to help people get their lives back on track as soon as possible.

Support Program for Employment Preparation

We support people's independence in daily life, social participation, and employment.

For those who are struggling with maintaining a stable daily life, or who are worried about building interpersonal relationships, job hunting, or employment, we draw up a support plan for employment over a period of six months to one year to help them prepare for employment.

Employment Training Program

For those who are finding it difficult to find regular employment immediately, we will provide help for them to use supported employment/work and other opportunities (job training provided by certified companies or offices).

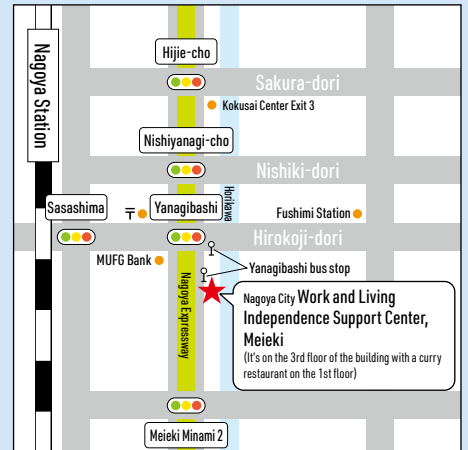

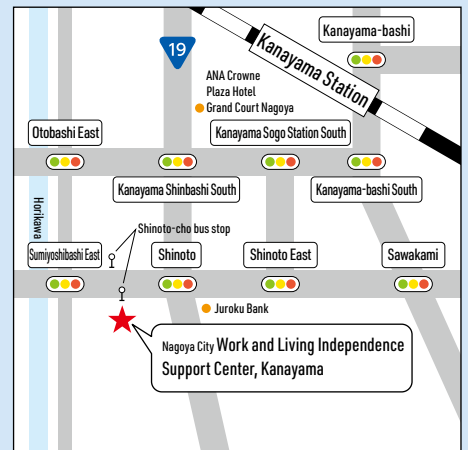

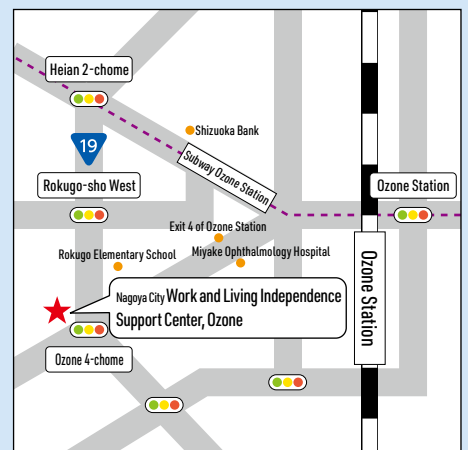
