

2026 School Attendance Financial Assistance Program

Financial Aid Notice

(Mirai Manabi Ouenkin)

(For the period from September 2026 through August 2027)

This program helps cover expenses related to your child's school life, including school supplies.

Electronic applications will be available starting in September 2026. You can now apply 24 hours a day using your smartphone or computer!

1. How to apply

Applications must be submitted electronically.

Scan the QR code on the right or access the Nagoya City Electronic Application Service's "School Attendance Financial Assistance Application" page via the URL below.

If you've already been approved and were informed that you must submit a new application through the new electronic application form on or after September 1, please apply using the QR code on the right or the URL above.

2. Application deadline

Wednesday, September 30, 2026

* Applications are accepted throughout the year (except in March). Benefits become available from the month in which your complete application is accepted. However, applicants whose children are not enrolled in a Nagoya City elementary or junior high school as of the first day of the application month become eligible beginning the following month. (Example: A complete application submitted in October 2026 → Benefits begin with October.)

3. Eligibility

(1) Eligibility categories (For category [2], every member of the household must meet the same criterion.)

- [1] Recipients of public assistance under the Public Assistance Act
- [2] Persons whose public assistance has been suspended or terminated
(*Does not apply if assistance ended because of a change in household composition, for example remarriage.)
- [3] Recipients of the child-raising allowance
(*Does not apply to other benefits such as the child allowance or the single-parent family allowance.)
- [4] Households whose income is at or below the eligibility threshold

Household size	Two-person household	Three-person household	Four-person household	Five-person household	Six-person household

□ For households of seven or more, add ¥462,000 to the income threshold for each additional household member.

The above thresholds apply when the combined total of each household member's gross income for 2025 (January through December), after deducting ¥100,000 per person, does not exceed the applicable income threshold. In addition, household members whose gross income is ¥580,000 or less are excluded from the household income calculation.

- * For screening purposes, “income” means “**gross income**.” “Gross income” means the “gross income amount” as defined in Article 313 Paragraph 1 of the Local Tax Act (Act No. 226 of 1950). This amount differs from annual earnings.
- * If the primary income earner experiences a significant loss of income due to unavoidable circumstances such as illness, injury, unemployment, dismissal, or company bankruptcy, your application may receive special consideration even if your 2025 gross income exceeds the eligibility threshold. (*Retirement at the mandatory retirement age or voluntary resignation does not qualify.)

- * If any household member lived outside Japan at any time between January and December 2025, you must attach documentation such as that person’s salary statements. ⇒For details, please see the official website. (*See page 3.)
- * In light of rising prices and other economic conditions, the income eligibility thresholds have been temporarily increased.

(2) Definition of household and calculation of household income

For the purposes of this program, a “household” refers to everyone who is living in the same house.

Even if grandparents or other relatives maintain separate finances or resident registrations, anyone living in the same home is considered part of the same household. In addition, a parent or guardian with parental authority who does not live in the same home because of a work assignment away from home or a similar reason is also considered part of the same household.

4. Approval period

The approval period begins in the month your complete application is accepted and continues through August 2027.

If you consent to the City reviewing and obtaining the information needed for screening, your approval will renew automatically each year unless your child graduates from junior high school, your household information changes, or you notify the City that you wish to withdraw. (Those who must submit additional documentation will receive separate instructions.)

If you were unable to apply between April and July 2026 or your application was not approved, you may submit a new application after September if you meet the eligibility requirements.

5. Supporting documentation

In principle, no supporting documentation is required.

*However, if your reason for applying is “[4] Household income is at or below the eligibility threshold” and any of the following applies, you must attach the required documents.

	When required	Required documents	Where to obtain the document
[1]	You moved to Nagoya City on or after January 2, 2026.	<u>A document showing the gross income of every household member (photographs are acceptable).</u>	Municipal Tax Office or the tax service counter at your ward office or branch office
[2]	Your income tax return has not been filed.	* In Nagoya City, this is the Municipal/Prefectural Resident Tax and Forest Environment Tax Certificate. (市民税・県民税・森林環境税証明書)	
[3]	You live at an address different from that of the student.	* You must submit the 2026 certificate (for 2025 income). * Certificates are not required for dependents under the Income Tax Act or for high school students and younger.	

* In cases [1] and [3], if your resident registration was outside Nagoya City as of January 1, 2026, you may be able to omit the above documentation by attaching your My Number Card or similar identification. For details, please see the application form or the official website.

6. Benefits and payment schedule

School supplies and related expenses, online learning communication expenses, school entrance preparation grants, graduation album costs, school lunch fees, outdoor activity expenses, school excursion expenses, commuting transportation expenses, School Life Management Guidance Form documentation fees, and school medical care

7. Notes and other information

- [1] Information related to school attendance financial assistance constitutes personal information and will be handled carefully to protect your privacy.
- [2] If your application is approved, the approval information will be provided to your child's school.
- [3] If corrections or errors in your application come to light and you no longer meet the eligibility requirements, your approval may be revoked. If there are questions about your application, the City may contact you to confirm the circumstances or verify your household composition and income through its own authority.
- [4] If your household circumstances change while you're receiving school attendance financial assistance (such as a change of guardian, remarriage, relocation, moving in with grandparents, or an increase in the number of household members), please notify your child's school promptly.
- [5] Approval and payment for the period from April through August 2027 are subject to the approval of the 2027 fiscal year budget. Please note that, depending on circumstances, approval and payment may not be provided as described in this notice or on the official website.
