School Education Goals

Accept Each Other and Live Happily as Yourself

Nagoyaka Junior High School aims to be a student-centered school where diversity is respected, each individual is valued, and everyone can learn in a safe and supportive environment.

✓ People who can enroll in evening junior high school

Those who have passed the age of compulsory education (15 years of age) and meet any of the conditions on the right can enter the school.

* Residents of Nagoya City or its affiliated municipalities

- ▶ Those who were unable to complete compulsory education for various reasons
- ▶ Foreign nationals who have not completed compulsory education in their home country
- ▶ Those who have not received sufficient compulsory education due to various circumstances, such as refusal to attend school

* "Compulsory education" refers to the educational curriculum equivalent to elementary and junior high school in Japan.

✓ This is what evening junior high school is like

- ▶ There are classes five days a week.
- ▶ All junior high school subjects are taught. (Japanese, social studies, math, science, English, music, art, health and physical education, technology and home economics, etc.)
- ▶ We also provide support for students learning Japanese.
*You can also study Japanese before classes begin.

- ▶ Classes are taught by teachers who have a teacher's license.
- ▶ Upon graduation, you will receive a junior high school diploma.
- ▶ Tuition is free, and textbooks are distributed at no cost.
- ▶ School lunches are available. You may also bring your own lunch.
- ▶ You can also start as a second- or third-year student.
