# Admission Requirements



Would you like to study with us at the evening junior high school?

#### What is Nagoyaka Junior High School?

Nagoya City established an evening junior high school in April 2025 to respond to the desire to study at school for people, regardless of nationality, who were unable to complete compulsory education for various reasons, or who were unable to attend school at all due to circumstances such as truancy / school refusal.

"Nagoyaka Junior High School" aims to be a "student-led school where diversity is respected, each individual is valued, and everyone can study with peace of mind."

### 1. People who are eligible to enroll in Nagoyaka Junior High School \* Eligibility for admission

People who live in Nagoya City, have passed the age of compulsory education (15 years old) (\*1), and meet one of the following criteria are eligible to enroll.

- (1) People who were unable to complete compulsory education for various reasons
- (2) Foreign nationals who have not completed compulsory education in their home country
- (3) People who did not receive adequate compulsory education due to non-attendance at school or other circumstances
- \*1. People born before April 1, 2011
- \* Please contact your local Board of Education if you live outside Nagoya City.

## 2. What you will study

- -Students will study all nine subjects (Japanese, social studies, math, science, English, music, art, health and physical education, and technology and home economics) just as students at ordinary junior high school study. Other activities include moral education class and school events.
- -It will be taught by a teacher with a junior high school teaching license.
- -After completing all courses, students can earn a diploma of junior high school.
- -Classes are conducted in Japanese.
- -For those who are not proficient in Japanese, we can provide the Japanese language support they need to take classes or study Japanese in other classrooms.
- -Students cannot study only a specific subject or Japanese language.

#### 3. Days with classes, study time

- -Classes are held Monday through Friday from 17:30 to 21:00.
- -Each class is 40 minutes. We have four classes a day.
- -There are breaks between classes.
- -We have summer, winter, and spring vacations.

#### 4. How to commute to school

- -Students should commute to the school on foot, by bicycle, or by public transportation (subway, bus, etc.).
  - \* Commuter passes are available at a student discount.

    Information on how to purchase commuter passes will be provided at the entrance information session (scheduled for late February).
- -In principle, students are not allowed to commute to the school by car or motorcycle.

#### 5. Location of Nagoyaka Junior High School

-Address: 4-19-1 Meieki, Nakamura Ward, Nagoya City (in Nagoya City Sasashima Elementary & Junior High School)



- -Public transportation:
  - -3-minute walk from Exit 4 of Kokusai Center Station on the Sakuradori Subway Line
  - -10-minute walk from Exit 5 of Nagoya Station on the Higashiyama Subway Line

#### 6. Others

- -Those who are working can also enroll.
- -There is no restriction on dress code. There is no uniform.
- -School meals are available.
- -No tuition is charged. Textbooks will be distributed free of charge.
- -There may be fees for learning materials, practical training, and other expenses necessary for study.
- -Depending on your family's financial situation, you may be able to take advantage of a system (evening junior high school support) that will eliminate these costs or refund the money later.
- -More details will be provided at the entrance information session (scheduled for late February).

#### 7. Enrollment process

- (1) Attend a school information session
  - -Explanation about evening junior high school and enrollment procedures will be given.
  - -Those who are considering enrollment are encouraged to attend information sessions as much as possible.
  - -After the school information session, those who wish can have individual consultations.
    - a. Dates of school information sessions
      - \*You can also observe classes at the 1st and 3rd sessions.

[2nd session] October 4, 2025 (Sat.),14:00-15:00

[3rd session] October 24, 2025 (Fri.), 17:30-19:00

  - -Nagoya City Nagoyaka Junior High School (4-19-1 Meieki, Nakamura Ward, Nagoya City)
- c. How to apply
  - -Please apply at least 3 days prior to the desired session date.

  - -If you would like to enroll in Nagoyaka Junior High School, please call Nagoyaka Junior High School to receive an explanation and then submit the necessary documents to enroll.

      - -Application form
      - -Interview materials
      - -A copy of certificate of residence (1 copy)
      - -Return envelope (No. 3 long envelope (120 mm x 235 mm) with an address label attached and a 460 yen stamp affixed)

    - -A 30-minute individual interview will be conducted.

-Health condition


-Commuting methods

- -Other individual circumstances and goals after enrollment, etc.
- e. Notification of interviews
  - -Nagoyaka Junior High School will contact you by phone to inform you of the date and time of the interview.
  - \* For foreign nationals, we will ask you to show your residence card during the interview.
- (4) Determination of enrollment
  - The results of admission will be sent by mail in January 2026.
  - An entrance information session is scheduled for late February.




- -If there is a difference between the submitted documents and the actual content of the interview, the interview may be redone.


