

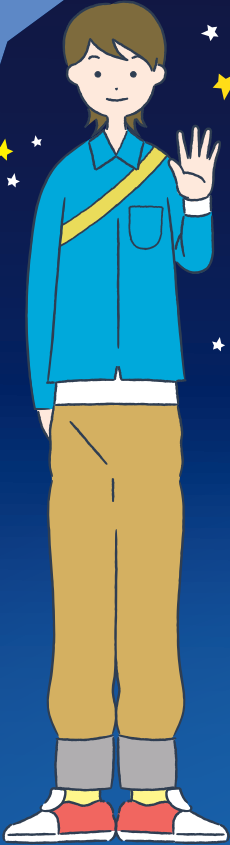

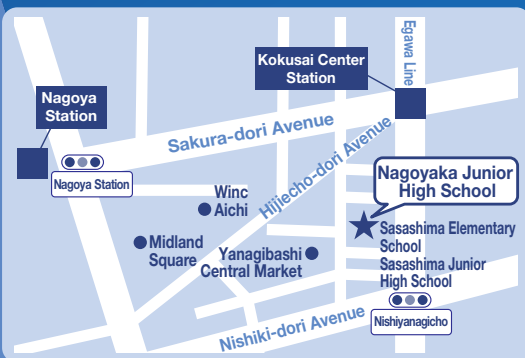
People who can enroll
in evening junior
high school

Those who have passed the age of compulsory education (15 years of age) and meet any of the following conditions can enter the school.

*Residents of Nagoya City or its affiliated municipalities

- ▶ Those who were unable to complete compulsory education for various reasons
- ▶ Foreign nationals who have not completed compulsory education in their home country
- ▶ Those who have not received sufficient compulsory education due to various circumstances, such as refusal to attend school

* "Compulsory education" refers to the educational curriculum equivalent to elementary and junior high school in Japan.

Nagoyaka Junior High School is like this

- ▶ There are classes five days a week.
- ▶ All junior high school subjects are taught. (Japanese, social studies, math, science, English, music, art, health and physical education, technology and home economics, etc.)
- ▶ We also provide support for students learning Japanese.
*You can also study Japanese before classes begin.
- ▶ Classes are taught by licensed teachers.
- ▶ Upon graduation, you will receive a junior high school diploma.
- ▶ Tuition is free and textbooks are provided free of charge.
- ▶ A school meal is available. You may also bring your own meal.
- ▶ You can enroll even if you are working.
- ▶ Depending on your academic ability, etc., you can also start from the second or third grade.

Nagoyaka Junior High School aims to be a student-centered school where diversity is respected, each individual is valued, and everyone can learn in a safe and supportive environment.
