

Nagoya City Board of Education

Initial Japanese Intensive Classes

for Students Attending Municipal Elementary and Junior High Schools in Nagoya City

- This program is designed to help students learn basic Japanese (e.g., daily conversation).
- It also includes lessons on Japanese school life (e.g., how to participate in class).
- There are three formats: in-person individual instruction, in-person group instruction, and remote instruction.
- Individual instruction is only available in the morning. In the afternoon, students return to their regular schools.
For group instruction, students choose between morning or afternoon. Please consult with your school or the "Japanese Language Education Consultation Center" considering your location and enrollment timing.
- Classes are free of charge. For in-person classes, elementary school students must be accompanied by a guardian.
- For elementary students who cannot be accompanied, or junior high students who live far from the classrooms and have difficulty attending in person, remote instruction is available.

Study Content	Basic Japanese (daily conversation, simple reading and writing) Japanese school life (how to attend classes, etc.)
Other	Group ① : After the session, students return to their school for lunch and participate in afternoon classes. Group ② : Students go to Sasashima Classroom after lunch at their school, and return home after the session. (First-year students can take classes from the second semester.)
