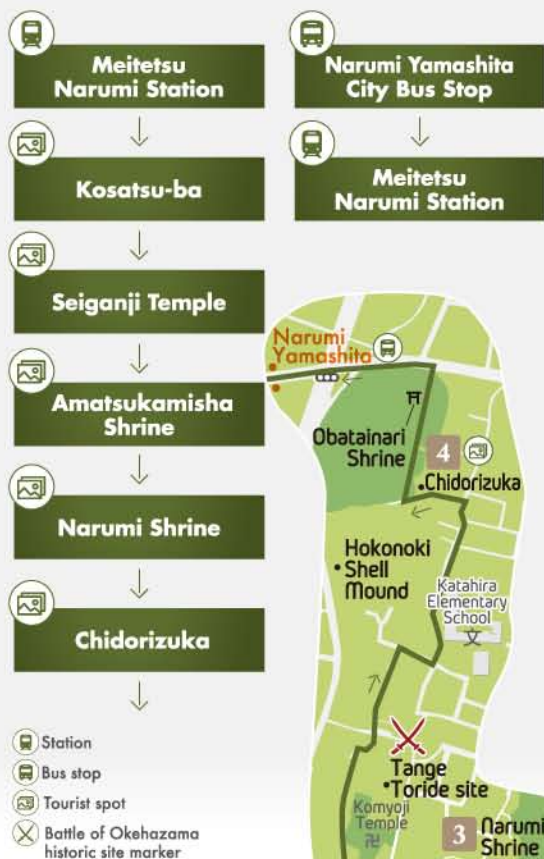


NARUMI

Course: About 1.5 hours [about 2km]



TOKAIDO NARUMI-SHUKU POST STATION

Narumi prospered as the fortieth post station on the Tokaido route. Famous haiku poet of the Edo period, Matsuo Basho came to Narumi four times.

Post station: These towns developed in the Edo period along the Tokaido and Nakasando ancient routes as rest stops and lodgings for travelers.

KOSATSU-BA

Kosatsu were signboards used in the Edo period by the shogunate government to post public notices. This one was restored in 2009.

SEIGANJI TEMPLE

The oldest stone monument in memory of Matsuo Basho is found on the grounds of this shrine.

NARUMI SHRINE

This shrine was built more than 1300 years ago. It is dedicated to Yamatotakeru, Miyasuhime, and Takeinadane from Japanese mythology.
