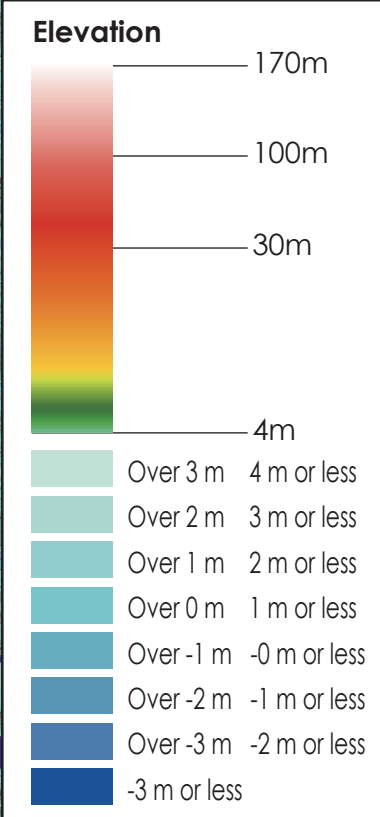
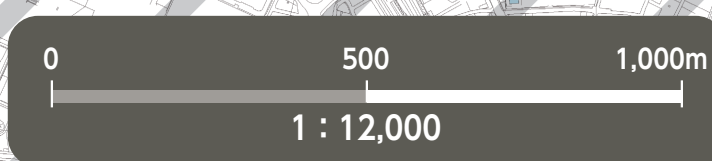

A designated evacuation shelter is a place you can use for shelter in case a disaster hits your home. You will be able to live here for a while. Go to your nearest shelter once it is safe to go outside.

- You may use the nearest designated evacuation shelter to you regardless of where you live.
 - Designated emergency evacuation shelters are places you can go in order to protect yourself from an impending disaster. Check the hazard map that best fits your situation to know where to go.
