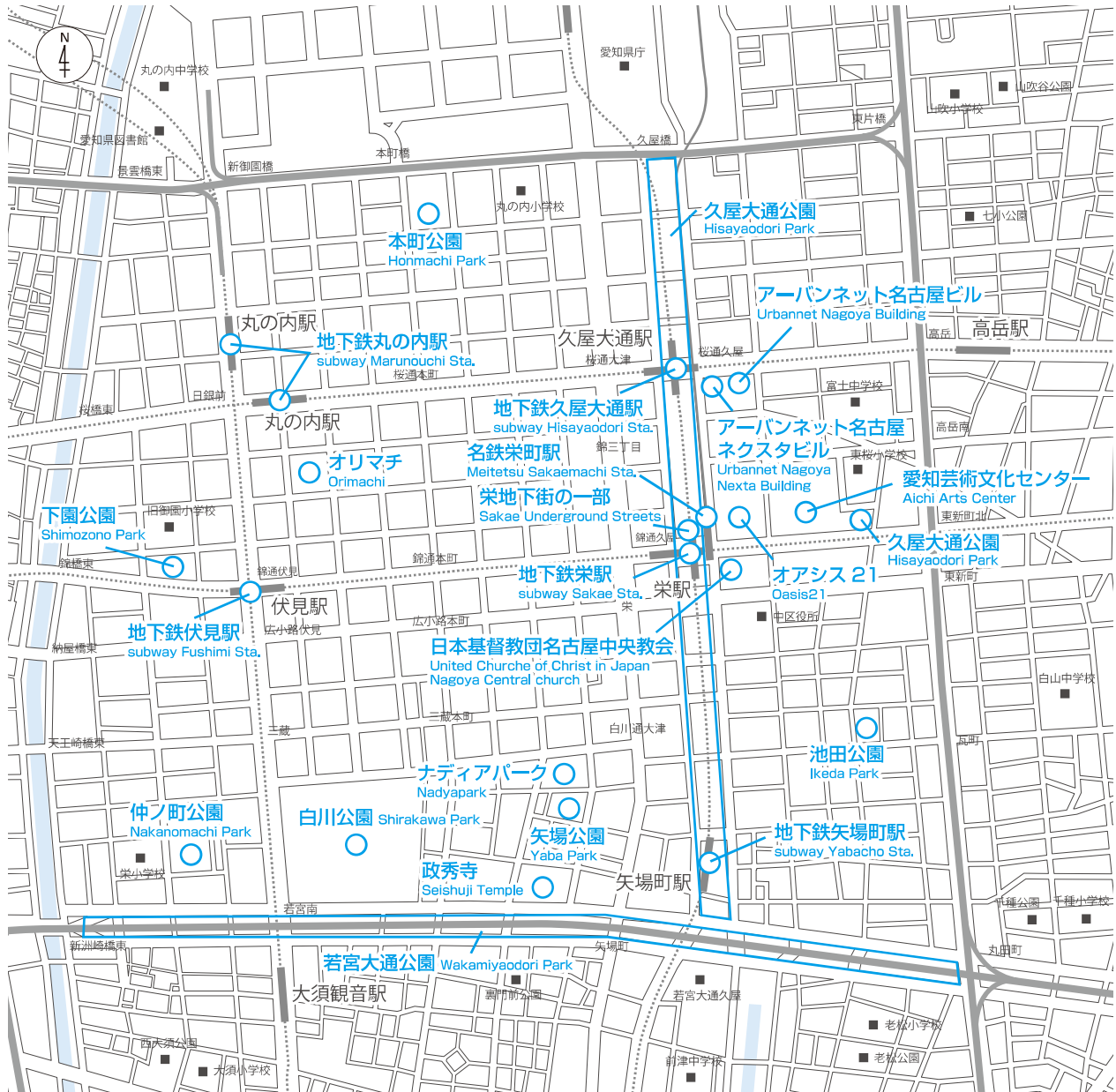


Temporary Evacuation Sites Map

(Fushimi Station Area, Sakae Station Area)

Available up to 6 hours following an earthquake

- ① Please evacuate to a safe location until the building you are in is confirmed to be safe.
- ② If your workplace or school is nearby, go and wait there.
- ③ If you are able to walk home or to your hotel, after the situation has calmed down, return home or to your hotel while checking your surroundings.



○ Temporary Evacuation Sites

If you are walking home or to your hotel:

Bathrooms are available at locations marked with "Walk-home assistance stations" such as convenience store's. You may receive tap-water if you have your own container.
