About the Earthquake Hazard Map

- This map shows the seismic intensity and liquefaction potential in various areas of the city based on the damage we could expect in case a Nankai Trough earthquake occurs. The expected damage was announced by the city in February 2014.
- In Nankai trough we assume the largest class earthquake considering various possibilities as an earthquake that would cause enormous damages should it happen, although the probability of the occurrence is as extremely low as once in 1000 years or less.

About seismic intensity

Seismic intensity	State
7	Tossed about by the shaking; cannot move without crawling; impossible to stand and thrown off by the shaking sometimes.
Upper-6	Difficult to keep standing.
Lower-6	Many people find it difficult to move; cannot walk without holding on to something.
Upper-5	Many people are frightened and want to hold on to something.

About liquefaction possibilities

Liquefaction possibilities	State
High	Liquefaction is highly likely to happen
Medium	Liquefaction is likely to happen
Low	Liquefaction is less likely to happen
None	Liquefaction is extremely unlikely to happen

*We can only talk about liquefaction in terms of possibility as it is difficult to predict the actual probability and areas of occurrence.

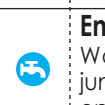
Designated Emergency Evacuation Shelter (shakes of earthquake, large scale fire) [Regional Evacuation Shelters]
Parks and green spaces that are designated emergency evacuation shelter for earthquakes and large fires that have space to protect evacuees from large-scale fires.



Designated Emergency Evacuation Shelters (shakes of earthquake) [Temporary Evacuation Sites]
Designated emergency evacuation shelters for earthquakes. You can temporarily shelter and check on the situation here.



Emergency water supply facilities (permanent and temporary water taps)
These facilities are provided at wide-area evacuation sites, etc., and are opened in the event of a disaster by municipal waterworks staff or private businesses owners that have settled support agreements with the Waterworks Bureau.



Emergency Water Supply Facilities (Underground hydrants)
Water supply taps are installed at all public elementary and junior high schools in the water supply area. The taps need to be operated by evacuees themselves in the event of a disaster.



Disaster emergency well (office)
Wells owned by private offices, factories, etc., made available to local residents in the event of a major earthquake to secure water for daily use (not drinking water).
