



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
REGARDING COOPERATION  
BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF NAGOYA  
AND**



**THE INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY HYDERABAD**

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MoU”) is jointly created by the City of Nagoya, Japan and the Indian Institute of Technology Hyderabad (“IITH”), Kandi, Sangareddy 502284, Telangana, India together referred to as the “Parties,” in order to encourage personnel and economic exchange between them via cooperation in the following areas.

**Article 1. Scope of Cooperation**

1. Both Parties shall cooperate as much as possible on personnel exchange initiatives between the two regions, in order to connect employers with students looking for work.
2. Both Parties shall cooperate as much as possible on economic exchange initiatives between the two regions, in order to foster global talent and promote innovation through industry-academia-government collaboration.
3. Both Parties shall cooperate as much as possible in providing the necessary information to enable companies and students from both regions to pursue opportunities in the other region.

**Article 2. Period of Validity**

1. This MoU takes effect from the date of signing.
2. This MoU will initially be valid for five (5) years and may be extended with the agreement of both Parties.
3. This MoU may be terminated by one Party giving six (6) months’ written notice.
4. If this MoU is terminated, the programs and initiatives started under the MoU will continue, to the extent that both Parties consent.

**Article 3. Legal Enforceability**

This MoU is not a legally binding contract and does not create legal responsibilities for either Party.

**Article 4. Miscellaneous**

Matters not defined in this MoU will be decided upon through discussion between the Parties.

Cooperation based on this MoU begins from the date both Parties sign it. This MoU will be executed in the English and Japanese languages at IITH on February 26, 2026, in two original copies. All copies will be signed by both Parties. One copy in each language will be kept by each Party, and both the English and Japanese versions shall be equally valid.


