

Recycling of Kitchen Waste

Recycling kitchen waste can create raw materials for fodder and composting. We ask for the cooperation of businesses that produce high amounts of kitchen waste. Food product wholesalers, retailers, restaurants and other companies offering food products have an obligation under the Food Recycling Law to recycle food waste to their utmost ability.

Recycling Pruned Branches

Pruned branches, grass clippings, and fallen leaves can be recycled into fuel and compost materials by chipping and other methods. We ask for the cooperation of businesses that produce high or consistent amounts of pruned branches, grass clippings, and fallen leaves.

Waste Disposal Methods for Business Related Activities

To All Organizations and Businesses, from the City of Nagoya

- The City does not collect business-related waste (except certain recyclable materials.)
- Submit a request to a licensed company for general waste collection such as burnable waste.
- Submit a request to an industrial waste disposal company for industrial waste such as waste plastic.
- Please recycle paper, food waste, and other recyclable materials to your utmost ability.

Responsibilities of Businesses

It is required for stores, offices, factories, hospitals, schools, public offices, etc., to take responsibility in the disposal of their own waste, regardless of the amount.

- The City will not collect business-related waste as household waste, no matter how small the amount (except certain recyclable materials.)
- If the address of your business and home is the same, separate and put out the waste incurred through the household, and waste incurred through business-related activities.)

It is necessary to reduce the amount of waste through recycling and other methods.

- Separating waste when it is disposed leads to recyclable materials.
- Managing the production and recycling of waste has effects on the cost of waste disposal.
- We ask for your cooperation in taking proactive steps towards waste reduction.

Types of Business-Related Waste



Disposal Method for Business-Related Waste (Industrial Waste)

Consign a disposal from a Licensed General Waste Collectors and Transporter

Separate your burnables, non-burnables, recyclables, etc and contract a licensed company to have them disposed.

※Consigning an unlicensed company is against the law.

Collection, Transportation, Disposal Fee

Confirm the collection, transportation, and disposal fees with the licensed company.

Transport to a disposal facility yourself

Separate burnable from non-burnable waste, and visit your ward's Environmental Works Office to apply for disposal. After, transport your burnables to a factory for incineration, and your non-burnables to a factory for crushing.

※Recyclables cannot be transported to a disposal facility.
※Please confirm the transportation method with the ward's Environmental Works Office.

City Disposal Facility Handling Fee

200 yen for 10 kg, or 4000 yen per 1 cubic meter.
※The handling fee for 1 cubic meter will apply if its weight is under 200 kg.
