
Keeping Crows out of your Garbage

1 Reduce your kitchen garbage

Try to cut down on kitchen garbage by reducing food scraps from cooking and leftovers.

2 Wrap your garbage when disposing

Wrap your kitchen garbage in newspaper or paper bags when you dispose of it so that the garbage inside is not visible.







3 Use a bird net

Cover your garbage with a bird net so that crows cannot get to it.

*Please be aware that if garbage bags are sticking out from under the net or if a weight is not used to keep the net down, it will be ineffective.

4 Put out your garbage out on the morning of its collection day

Crows are very active in the early morning. If you put your garbage out before the collection day, it can be targeted by crows. Putting your garbage out at night can also cause problems with cats. Please put your garbage out on the morning of its collection day.
