Community childcare support centers

In Nagoya City, various community-based facilities offer support to families with children, mainly under three years of age (community childcare support centers).

What community childcare support centers offer:

- * Children can play with toys and picture-books in a safe setting. Staff help children make friends with other children, and also encourage parents to chat with other parents.
- ★ Staff offer parenting advice when requested.
- * Parenting workshops are organized from time to time.

★ Child and Childcare Support Center★

(758 (Nagoya) Kids Station)

758 Kids Station is conveniently located on the 6th floor of Nadya Park in Yaba-cho, where you can casually drop in with your child after shopping nearby. It has a "Kids Park" where children and parents can play together and a breastfeeding room, and various parenting workshops are organized. The facility is staffed by a parenting advisor, who can discuss parenting problems and give

★Parenting support centers★

These facilities are conveniently located near subway and other stations. Staff include qualified parenting support coordinators such as nursery teachers, who are keen to help parents with problems. Please feel free to discuss any problems with them. Temporary childcare service is also available.

- Fee: None in principle (Temporary childcare service is offered for 1,200 yen for up to six hours. The fee may be waived or reduced if certain conditions are met.)
- Open dates and hours: At least five days a week and at least six hours a day (Open dates and hours vary depending on the center.)

Community childcare support centers

These centers are open in convenient locations such as nurseries and condominium rooms in your neighborhood.

- Fee: None in principle
- Open dates and hours: At least five days a week and at least five hours a day (Open dates and hours vary depending on the center.)

Children's centers

Children's centers are designed to promote the physical and psychological health of children and are open to anyone. These facilities have club rooms, playrooms, libraries, and halls, and hold various club activities and events. They are also used as venues for the activities of parents' groups.

Todagawa Children's Land



Todagawa Children's Land consists of three zones: the Hill Zone with large wooden play equipment and ball pool; the Water Zone where children can play with water, e.g., bathing in a pond and riding a raft; and the Handmade Zone where craft-making and cooking classes are held (prior application is required). E-Able Nagoya



At E-Able Nagoya, various workshops and events are held, focusing on lifestyles and self-supported living of both men and women, and supporting the employment and empowerment of women. The training rooms can be rented as venues for learning and networking. It also has a library with many books on gender issues, including lifestyles of women and gender equality. A babysitting service is available for all the workshops, as well as for those who use the facility for their studies. (Children from one year old up to preschool age are accepted for the babysitting service, subject to prior application.)

Lifelong learning centers



Lifelong learning centers offer various learning opportunities for parents, such as parenting workshops to learn what parents can do for children and how they can better enjoy being parents, as well as hands-on learning programs for children and events for parents and children to enjoy together. Meeting rooms and gyms are available for rent for study meetings and other group activities. A babysitting service is offered for some workshops to encourage the participation of parents with little children. (Children from two years old up to preschool age are accepted.)
