About the “Nagoyakko Support Information Relay Sheet”



1. Purpose:

This information relay sheet is made in order for your children to have a more comfortable experience at school, continuing the support they have received at home, kindergarten, or daycare.

2. Eligibility:

Students who are planning on entering school the next fiscal year, who require special support in their everyday school lives.

3. About the Completion of this Information Relay Sheet:

- The kindergarten or daycare will complete this sheet together with the parent or legal guardian who requests it.
- The details on this sheet are private personal information. The creation and usage of this sheet will be handled with the utmost care, and will not be used for any reasons besides the purpose outlined above.

Making the “Nagoyakko Support Information Relay Sheet”

Parent or guardian requests to make and use the Information Relay Sheet



The sheet is made together with the kindergarten or daycare, and sent to the next school upon agreement.



The kindergarten or daycare submits the sheet to the next school (around October/November)



Parent or guardian and next school decide on a date to discuss support options.

How Schools Use the “Nagoyakko Support Relay Information Sheet”:

- During conversations between guardians and schools
- During entry into new schools to explain the history of care for your child during kindergarten and day care.
- Information can be exchanged between teachers at kindergartens and day cares with the permission of the guardians.
- Possibility to coordinate with related institutions if necessary.
