- Those who were unable to complete compulsory education for various reasons
- ► Foreign nationals who have not completed compulsory education in their home country
- Those who have not received sufficient compulsory education due to various circumstances, such as refusal to attend school

Nagoyaka Junior High School will be like this:

There are classes five days a week.

- All junior high school subjects are taught. (Japanese, social studies, math, science, English, music, art, health and physical education, technology and home economics, etc.)
- We also provide support for students learning Japanese.
- Classes are taught by teachers who have a teacher's license.
- Upon graduation, you will receive a junior high school diploma.
- Tuition is free and textbooks are provided free of charge.
- School lunches are available. You may also bring your own lunch.
- You will be able to enroll even if you are working.
- Depending on your academic ability, etc., you will also be able to start from the second or third grades.

Nagoyaka Junior High School aims to be a student-centered school where diversity is respected, each individual is valued, and everyone can learn in a safe and supportive environment.
