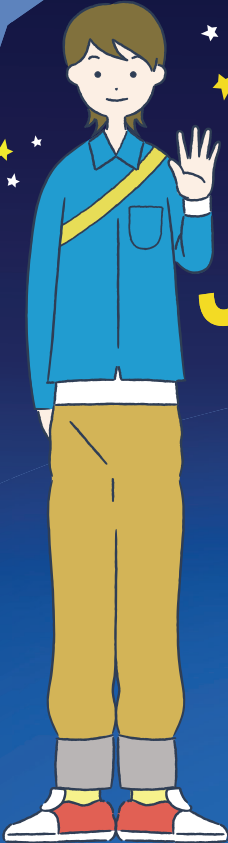

Those who have passed the age of compulsory education (over 15) and meet any of the following conditions can enter the school.

- ▶ Those who were unable to complete compulsory education for various reasons
- ▶ Foreign nationals who have not completed compulsory education in their home country
- ▶ Those who have not received sufficient compulsory education due to various circumstances, such as refusal to attend school

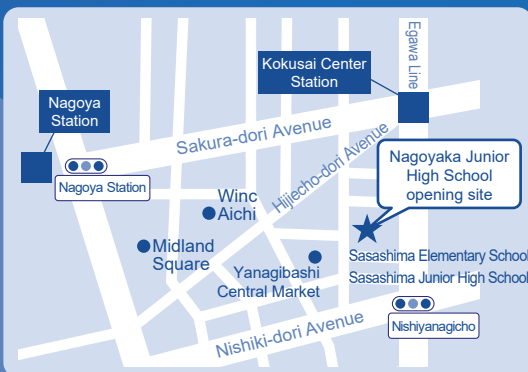
## Where Nagoyaka Junior High School will be:

## A normal day at evening junior high school (tentative)

5:30 pm - 5:35 pm	Homeroom
5:35 pm - 6:15 pm	1st period (40 minutes)
6:15 pm - 6:40 pm	Break
6:40 pm - 7:20 pm	2nd period (40 minutes)
7:25 pm - 8:05 pm	3rd period (40 minutes)
8:10 pm - 8:50 pm	4th period (40 minutes)
8:50 pm - 9:00 pm	Homeroom

- ▶ There are classes five days a week.
- ▶ All junior high school subjects are taught (Japanese, social studies, math, science, English, music, art, health and physical education, technology and home economics, etc.)
- ▶ Classes are taught by teachers who have a teacher's license.
- ▶ You will graduate from junior high school after you complete all classes.
- ▶ Tuition will be free.
- ▶ Textbooks will be given out free of charge.
- ▶ You will be able to enroll even if you are working.
- ▶ Depending on your academic ability, etc., you will also be able to start from the second or third grades.
- ▶ We are considering providing school meals.

Each class will be 40 minutes long, and there will be four classes a day.

There will be a break between classes.
