


What is the City of Nagoya enrollment grant?

This program aims to offer 70,000 yen to cover expenses when your child will enroll in high school, etc. in Aichi Prefecture.



- A third-year junior high school student who lives in the city and is enrolled in junior high school, etc. in Aichi Prefecture
- Plans to enroll in high school, etc. in Aichi Prefecture (a correspondence course outside the prefecture also covered)
- Meets the financial conditions (reference: a household of four with the annual revenue of less than 5.90 million yen = Equivalent to the conditions for Mirai Manabi Ouen-kin (school financial aid program))

Flow from application to disbursement

- Distribution of a notice from school
- Application procedure Apply through the webpage in principle. (For the procedure and attachments required to apply, visit the webpage.)
- Review/determination A review will be conducted based on the submitted certificate, etc., and the result will be notified via email.
- **Grant claim** If an applicant is determined to be eligible in 3, submit the admission notice, etc. from the webpage after passing the entrance examination for a school covered by the program.
- Disbursement If the documents submitted in 4 are reviewed and deemed complete and accurate, the City of Nagoya enrollment grant will be disbursed.
